

KEY 5: DYING TO YOURSELF

“This is perhaps the key that you’d rather not collect along your journey to unlocking the power of Communion. However, you’ve come this far and you’re changing the narrative of your story. Please don’t let all that hard work be in vain because now you’re in miracle territory.

Now, like I said before, God doesn’t do formulas, this is why every time Jesus healed someone, it was different. As humans we seem to think that if something worked once, then it will work again.

God doesn’t fit into those boxes we tend to put Him in.

However, since I’ve been taking Communion regularly at the time of this recording, which has been about three years, I have been astonished at the things God has been doing in my life. Over those years, I’ve been on a journey to learn to die to myself daily and it’s an ongoing process.

Communion taking is like hitting the reset button every day.

Communion taking is about maturing in your faith.

Communion taking is leaning on God’s goodness and faithfulness in your covenant relationship with Him”
